

# Mining Heritage Sites – St Just to Gurnards Head

**7m:11.2km** The Crowns at **Botallack**, Levant Mine at **Trewellard** and Geevor at **Pendeen** are all situated off the B3306 between St Just and St Ives. The coastline on this road all the way to St Ives, has many other mining remains, most are visible from the B3306. There are some steep hills!

→ **1m:1.6km** Follow the signs to **Cape Cornwall** from **St Just**, which is a short but steep cycle ride from the town square. Take the turning to **Carn Glouce** off the **Cape Cornwall** road for views across the Cape, **The Scilly Isles** and of **Lands End**

→ **1m:1.6km** Heading North East from **St Just** towards **St Ives**, turn left into **Botallack** and take the track left after the Queens Pub to see the Crown Mines. The coast path beyond here continues to the Levant Mine, but some sections of the track are not suitable for hybrid or road bikes

→ **2m:3.2km** The Levant Mine is signed left at **Trewellard**, its a 1mile trip downhill to the mine and the coast

→ Geevor Mine is a few hundred metres beyond the Levant Mine turn off, in **Pendeen**

→ Head down to **Pendeen Lighthouse** after the CostCutter shop (1 mile downhill from the B3306) in **Pendeen**

→ **7m:11.2km** There are more mining sites beyond **Morvah** at **Bosigran** and **Porthmeor**, however after the excellent **Gurnards Head** public house, the B3306 gets very hilly all the way to **St Ives**, but the views of the coastline are stunning
